

## Mid Dorset Darts AGM – Winter League 2023-2024

1. The AGM was opened at 8pm on the 1<sup>st</sup> October 2023, at the Con Club, Blandford. The League Secretary welcomed all those present.
2. The League Secretary read out the Financial Statement. At the time of the AGM the League has a balance of £1041.53 carried over from the previous season.
3. The League Secretary agreed to stay in post for a further season. **This was agreed by those present.**
4. 10 Teams were registered, and fees paid in accordance with Rule 2.
5. Due to the length of previous seasons, it was proposed to have 2 Sections for this season. **Agreed.**

The results from the Summer League were used as a means of dividing the Teams, based on their final position and as follows:

The season will now be considerably shorter, and it was proposed that we bring back the Team KO Competition, with **all Teams** competing as 1 section. The Draw for this will be done by the League Secretary and other Team Captain at the first game of the season. **Agreed.**

Due to the change in the league format, it was proposed that extra trophies will be provided for **normal League Team events only** and **all other individual accolades and competitions** will be awarded on the basis of 1 section only. **Agreed.**

As a result of this, the League will provide Trophies for Section A and Section B, as follows:

All other trophies will be awarded, based on 1 Section, as follows:

Leading Dartist – Men & Ladies	Highest Shot In – Men & Ladies

Winners and Runners Up, and where applicable, Mens & Ladies trophies for:

Captains Cup, Trebles, Mixed Pairs, Pairs and Singles. **(Finals being played on Finals Night)**

The League Secretary pointed out that due to having a shorter season, the league's annual income will be reduced and if this format is to continue a review of registration, match and competition fees may be necessary. This will need to be discussed at the 2024 AGM.

6. Nominations were put forward for this year's Charity and it was decided that we would again hold a Charity Darts Competition in support of the **Friends of PICU and Fortuneswell Cancer Trust**. It was proposed that the competition takes place on **Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> February 2024** with the time, venue and format to be confirmed on confirmation of players. All players must be registered and the entry fee will be £5 per person, to cover refreshments. The League will again donate the prize money. **Agreed.**
7. The League Secretary proposed and read out amendments/additions to Rule 1 & 19. All other rules remain current. The League Rules can be viewed on the League Website.
8. It was proposed that the Winter League commences on **Monday 6<sup>th</sup> November, 2023** and will conclude with Finals & Presentation Night on **Friday 5<sup>th</sup> April 2024**, all venues to be confirmed.
